History Skills:
History skills will be assessed and developed in all lessons throughout Key Stages 3 and 4. The colour code indicates where these skills are specifically targeted.

Historical Knowledge (AO1)
Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the key features and characteristics of the periods studied.

Significance (AO2)
Explain and analyse historical events and periods studied using second-order historical concepts (causation, similarity and difference, historical significance).

Sources (AO3)
Analyse, evaluate and use sources (contemporary to the period) to make substantiated judgements, in the context of historical events studied.

Analyse and Evaluate (AO4)
Analyse, evaluate and make substantiated judgements about interpretations (including how and why interpretations may differ) in the context of historical events studied.
