Many organisations charge for their services. Some people purchase these services directly by using benefits or savings. Others may use a Personal Budget/Direct Payments/Care Package if agreed by the Local Authority 0-25 Together Service

Live a little is available all year round and people can attend up to 5 days a week depending on personal budgets. A standard day is a 6 hour session Monday to Friday 9:30am to 3:30pm, and they also run two later sessions a week on request. They charge in line with what the standard hourly rate in the local area is. Transportation: Clients will be collected and dropped home; more information will be given once you join
